The Commissioning of the Disciples

The eleven disciples went to Galilee, to the mountain to which Jesus had ordered them. When they saw him, they worshiped, but they doubted. Then Jesus approached and said to them, "All power in heaven and on earth has been given to me. Go, therefore, and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit, teaching them to observe all that I have commanded you. And behold, I am with you always, until the end of the age."

MATTHEW, CHAPTER 28: 16-20 (NABRE)

On April 30, 2000, St. John Paul officially designated the Sunday after Easter as Divine Mercy Sunday. The request for this feast was made by Jesus during his apparitions to St. Faustina and was fulfilled the day of her canonization.

In addition to His request that Divine Mercy Sunday be designated, Jesus had entrusted to Faustina His desire for the following devotions:

- * That a special image be painted and venerated with the words, “Jesus I trust in you” noted on it.
- * That at 3 O’clock His Mercy be implored, even if for a moment
- * A Chaplet of Divine Mercy be prayed as a powerful weapon –especially by and on behalf of the dying.
- * A novena be said starting on Good Friday through Divine Mercy Sunday
